She worked as a Postdoctoral Fellow in various Institutions in France: Université des Sciences de Montpellier II (Lab Génome et Populations), at CHU Nancy (Lab d'AnatomiePathologique), CHU Brabois, (INSERM U14, Poste Vert), Etablissement of Transfusion Sanguine de Lorraine (Lab de Chimie Hématologique) and Regional Center of Transfusion Sanguine (Lab de Génétique) from 1992 to 1996. In October 1996, she began her collaboration with the A' Department of Propaedeutic Surgery, where she is currently working). She has 24 publications (hindex: 9) and her total bibliographical references are 327. In addition to her teaching work, her research interests focus on investigating biological and genetic pathways involved in the pathogenesis of important medical entities such as cancer and sepsis.
