

Nikolaos Memos, MD, MSc PhD

General Surgeon Surgical Oncologist

Mr Memos was born in Athens in 1978. He received his MD in 2003 and his PhD in 2006 from the University of Athens. During 2003 to 2009 he has been a PhD candidate at the Laboratory of Surgical Research of the A' department of Propaedeutic Surgery, Athens Medical School. Between 2005-2007, he received his master's in Biostatistics from the Mathematical and Medical school of the University of Athens and since then he has performed numerous analysis related to several pathological entities (oncology, sepsis) most of which are part of peer reviewed publication. In 2009 he started his surgical training at the A Department of Propaedeutic Surgery of Athens University until 2015. Between 2015-2017, he received his surgical oncology training at the Royal Marsden Hospital in London, UK and between 2017-2018, he was appointed as a Locum Consultant at the Melanoma and Soft Tissue Sarcoma Unit at the Royal Marsden Hospital. He came back in Greece in 2019 and started organizing the Sarcoma and Rare Cancers Unit at the B Department of Surgery of the Aretaieio University Hospital in Athens where he is employed as surgical oncologist. His main fields of interest are surgical oncology of soft tissue sarcoma, melanoma and gastrointestinal malignancies as well biostatistics. He has 22 publications in international peer-reviewed Journals. He has more than 50 presentations in international conferences, where he has been awarded 3 first prizes and has been teaching medical students and nursing staff in surgical oncology.
